## Section C -- During the Report Period, KEET engaged in the following recruitment initiatives:

1. KEET's internship program with Cal Polytech Humboldt and College of the Redwoods is designed to assist members of the community to acquire skills needed for broadcast employment. During the Fall 2023 and Spring 2024 KEET hosted an internship program for students from Cal Polytech Humboldt and from College of the Redwoods.
